Description

Tehimpuls - The Regional Innovation and Technology Transfer Centre is a non-governmental, non-profit organization, with legal personality, started in 2006 within the Regional Innovation Strategy of West Region, initiative coordinated by the West Regional Development Agency. Within the members of the association, there are four regional universities (Politehnica University of Timișoara, “Aurel Vlaicu” University in Arad, West University of Timișoara, University of Agriculture and Veterinary Medicine of Banat-Timișoara and “Vasile Goldis” Western University of Arad), the West Regional Development Agency, two multidisciplinary associations (Association for Multidisciplinary Research in the West Region and Romanian Engineers’ Association - Timișoara Branch) and two companies (Azur SA and Obrist Eastern Europe SRL).
